Selected candidates will be liable to serve anywhere in India or abroad. On appointment, the candidates shall be governed by the ITBPF Act, 1992 and ITBPF Rules, 1994 and other Rules applicable from time to time. Applications from interested and eligible candidates will be accepted through ONLINE MODE only. No other mode for submission of application is allowed. ONLINE APPLICATION MODE WILL BE OPENED W.E.F. 24TH DECEMBER, 2024 (24/12/2024) AT 00:01 AM AND WILL BE CLOSED ON 22ND JANUARY, 2025 (22/01/2025) AT 11:59 PM. The applicants are advised to check their eligibility before applying, so as to avoid disappointment at a later stage.

b) Cutoff date for Age and Relaxations :

Crucial date for determining the age limit will be the closing date i.e. 22nd January, 2025 (22/01/2025). Candidates should not have been born earlier than 23rd January, 2000 (23/01/2000) and later than 22nd January, 2007 (22/01/2007).

Note:-

- i) The date of Birth as recorded in the Matriculation certificate available on the date of submission of application shall be accepted as proof for determining the age and no subsequent request for its change will be considered or granted.
- Crucial date for determining the age limit/eligibility etc. shall be the closing date of receipt of online applications from candidates.
- Certificates for claiming SC/ST status should be issued before the closing date for receipt of online applications.
- iv) Candidates claiming Economically Weaker Sections (EWS) status may note that their certificate of Income & Assets should be based on the financial year prior to the year of application and should be in possession before the closing date for submission of online applications, i.e. 22nd January, 2025 (22/01/2025).
- v) Candidates claiming OBC (NCL) status may note that certificate on Non-Creamy Layer status should be based on the income earned during three previous financial years (i.e. 2023-24, 2022-23 and 2021-22) and should be in possession before the closing date of submission of online applications, i.e. 22nd January, 2025 (22/01/2025).
- vi) Candidates who wish to be considered against reserved vacancies or seeking age relaxation must submit requisite certificate issued by the competent authority, in the prescribed format, when such certificates are sought by the Recruitment Board. Explanation of Ex-servicemen:

 - a) Who either has been retired or relieved or discharged from such service whether at his own request or being relieved by the employer after earning his or her pension.

b) Who has been relieved from such service on

medical grounds attributable to military service or circumstances beyond his control and awarded medical or other disability pension.

Or

 Who has been released from such service as a result of reduction in establishment.

Or

(ii) Who has been released from such service after completing the specific period of engagement, otherwise than at his own request, or by way of dismissal, or discharge on account of misconduct or inefficiency and has been given a gratuity: and includes personnel of the Territorial Army, namely, pension holders for continuous embodied service or broken spells of qualifying service;

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(iii) Personnel of the Army Postal Service who are part of regular Army and retired from the Army Postal Service without reversion to their parent service with pension, or are released from the Army Postal Service on medical grounds attributable to or aggravated by military service or circumstances beyond their control and awarded medical or other disability pension;

Or

(iv) Personnel, who were on deputation in Army Postal Service for more than six months prior to the 14th April, 1987.

- (i) A color blind person will not be eligible for appointment. If a person is found colour blind at any stage of service career, he will be boarded out as per SHAPE policy in vogue in ITBPF.
- (ii) The candidate must not have knock knees, flat foot, varicose veins or squint in the eyes and should possess high colour vision.
- (iii) Must be in good mental and bodily health and free from any physical defect likely to interfere with the efficient performance of the duties.

(b) Tattoos: -

- i) <u>Content</u>: Being a secular country, the religious sentiments of our countrymen are to be respected and thus, tattoos depicting religious symbol or figures and the name, as followed in Indian Army are to be permitted.
- ii) <u>Location</u>: Tattoos marked on traditional sites of the body like inner aspect of forearm but only left forearm, being non saluting limb or dorsum of the hands are to be allowed.
- iii) <u>Size</u>: Size must be less than ¼ of the particular part (Elbow or Hand) of the body.

Note:-

In case, a candidate has undergone removal of tattoo (s) prior to appearing for recruitment process and the same has faded substantially, this will be treated as a "scar" and not a tattoo. Such candidates will be permitted to undergo the entire selection process with the approval of Presiding Officer of the recruitment Board. Further, the scar resulting due to removal of tattoo will be reviewed by the Medical Board of Officer during Detailed Medical Examination.

5. HOW TO APPLY AND BY WHICH DATE:

- a) Eligible and interested candidates need to apply online through ITBPF website https://recruitment.itbpolice.nic.in. Candidates are advised to fill the online application form after reading the instructions carefully and should provide genuine and functional e-mail ID and Mobile number at the time of filling online application form. Details as required under various segments should be mentioned clearly, correctly and logically. As the applications need to be submitted online only, applications received offline shall not be considered and will be rejected summarily.
- Candidates are to fill all information e.g. Gender/Category (UR/SC/ST/OBC (NCL)/EWS etc), Employment status/Riots affected, etc.

in the profile created on ITBP recruitment website before submission of online application. Any false/incorrect information in online application will lead to cancellation of candidature and no request for change in such details will be considered at later stages.

c) APPLICATION FEE & MODE OF PAYMENT- Male candidates belonging to UR, OBC and EWS category applying for this recruitment will have to pay Rs. 100/- (Rupees one hundred only) as application fee through the online payment gateway system on https://recruitment.itbpolice.nic.in. Application received with any other mode of fee payment will be summarily rejected. Candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribe and Ex-servicemen are exempted from paying the fee.

Note:-

- i) Fee once paid will not be refunded under any circumstances.
- ii) Fee paid by modes other than online mode will not be accepted and the applications of such candidate will be rejected forthright. Besides above, the payment made in such cases shall stand forfeited.
- d) Candidates working in Central/State Government/ Autonomous/ Statutory Bodies/ Public Sector Undertaking etc. applied to the post are required to furnish "No Objection Certificate" in original as per Annexure-VI issued by the employer at the time of verification of documents. The candidature of candidates who fail to submit "No Objection Certificate" at the time of documentation shall be summarily rejected.
- e) Online application mode will be opened w.e.f. 24th December, 2024 (24/12/2024) at 00:01 a.m. and will be closed on 22nd January, 2025 (22/01/2025) at 11:59 p.m.

- g) Candidates are strongly advised to apply well in time without waiting for the last date for submission of online application form.

6. SELECTION PROCESS:

- a) Admit Cards to the candidates will be issued online mentioning the date and venue of recruitment test. Candidature of candidates who are issued online admit cards will remain provisional till they are finally selected and submit all related documents/certificates in original and in prescribed format at the stage of verification of original documents.
- Candidates are required to bring a clear & legible print out of their online application form & admit card; else they will not be permitted to enter the venue of Physical Efficiency Test (PET) & Physical Standard Test (PST).

Note:-

- Before start of PET & PST, the candidates will undergo thorough verification of identity including Biometric capture.
- Biometric identification of candidates can also be verified at any stage of recruitment.
- (iii) It is candidate's responsibility to check before hand that the biometric machines are able to capture the fingerprint image. In case, if the biometric machine is not able to capture the fingerprint image due to Mehndi, wax, etc. then, the candidate will not be allowed to appear in the examination.
- (iv) Failure in biometric verification at any stage will lead to cancellation of candidature.

- (ii) The candidates who are declared not qualified in physical standard i.e. height & chest (as applicable) may prefer an appeal in writing to the Presiding Officer on the same day, if they so desire, for remeasurement.
- (iii) Rejection slip for less in Height and Chest will be issued at the time of PST. Board shall ensure that measurement is mentioned in writing in the rejection slip. In case, if any candidate is not satisfied with the physical measurement recorded by the Board, he may make a representation/appeal in writing to the Presiding Officer of the Recruitment Board on same day for re-measurement. In such case, the physical measurement of aggrieved candidate(s) shall be measured by the Presiding Officer himself and shall dispose off the representation/appeal immediately in writing to the candidate then and there. The decision of Presiding Officer will be final and no further appeal or representation in this regard will be entertained thereafter. 3. VERIFICATION

(DOCUMENTATION)

The candidates, who qualify in Physical Standard Test (PST) will be put through verification of original documents. Original documents will be returned on the spot after verification and self attested copies of certificates will be retained with the application. Original copy of following documents will be required for verification:-

- (i) Educational certificate(s) along with Diploma certificate(s) and experience certificate etc.
- (ii) Matriculation or 10th class pass certificate for verification of date of birth (DOB).
- (iii) Scheduled Caste (SC) and Scheduled Tribe (ST) certificate as per Annexure-'1', OBC certificate as per Annexure-'II' and Economically Weaker Section (EWS) certificate (valid for the year 2023-24) as per Annexure-'III' (if belonging to any of these categories) issued by an Authority not lower than Tehsildar or SDM. Certificates obtained in any other format will not be accepted. Candidates claiming OBC status may note that certificate on Non-Creamy Layer status as per Annexure-'II-A' should be based on the income earned during three previous financial years (i.e. 2023-24, 2022-23 and 2021-22) and must ensure that he should be in possession of caste/community and Non-Creamy Layer (NCL) certificate before the closing date for submission of online applications, i.e. 22nd January, 2025 (22/01/2025).
- (iv) Candidates seeking reservation as OBC (NCL) shall submit a declaration as Annexure-'II-A'.
- (v) Persons serving in Government Services applying for the post are required to furnish "No Objection Certificate" in original as per Annexure-'VI' issued by their employer at the time of physical verification of documents. Candidates, who fail to submit N.O.C. at the time of documentation, shall be summarily rejected.
- (vi) Certificate as per Annexure-'V' for relaxation in height or chest (if applicable).
- (vii) Domicile certificate issued by Local Revenue Authorities or PAN Card or Aadhar Card or

Driving License or Voter Card etc. for verification of citizenship. In case of West Pakistani Refugees settled in Jammu & Kashmir (UT), they are required to produce certificate in the format attached as Annexure-'IV' issued by the Sarpanch/Numberdar of the candidate's village to the effect that the person belonged to the West Pakistani Refugees Category, along with a copy of Electoral Roll showing the name of the candidate in the Voter List for elections to the Parliamentary Constituency.

- (viii) Discharge certificate in case of Ex-servicemen.
- (ix) Four latest passport size photographs.

Note :-

- (i) The board is competent to take final decision in accepting/rejecting candidature of a candidate, if he does not produce certificates as required on his behalf, in support of educational & age etc.
- (ii) Candidates who fail to qualify at the stage of documentation shall be eliminated and rejection slip shall be issued by the Presiding Officer.

4. WRITTEN EXAMINATION (100 Marks)

- (i) The candidates qualified in documentation will be required to undergo Written Examination. Admit cards to the candidates will be issued online by mentioning date and venue of the written test. Candidates have to download online admit card from ITBPF recruitment website i.e. https://recruitment.itbpolice.nic.in.
- (ii) The written examination carrying 100 marks will consist of objective type multiple choice questions. However, pattern of written test i.e. Computer Based Test (CBT) or OMR based will be at the discretion of ITBPF. The pattern of question paper of written examination will be as under:-

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NOTE:

There are 20 questions for Hindi and 20 questions for English each and candidates have an option to attempt 20 questions in either of the languages.

- The questions for written examination shall be of 10th standard.
- iv) Answer key of the question paper will be uploaded on ITBP recruitment website, i.e. https://recruitment.itbpolice.nic.in after the written examination is completed.
- v) The setting of question paper, answer key and answer sheets for written examination shall be arranged by Out Sourced Agency/Nodal Officer/Dte.Genl., ITBPF.
- vi) Candidates are not permitted to use electronic gadgets including Mobile Phones, calculators, paper, digital wrist watch or any other electronic/electrical device inside examination hall. Possession of these items, whether in use or not, will be considered as "use of unfair means" in the examination and appropriate action will be taken against such candidates.
- vii) The minimum cut off percentage of qualifying marks of written examination is as under:-
 - (a) General & EWS category : 35%
 - (b) SC/ST/OBC (NCL) category: 33%
- viii) Defective question booklet may be replaced, if any candidate makes a request within 10 minutes from the commencement of the paper of Written Examination.
- ix) Candidates found copying or using any unfair means should be disqualified and debarred from further test. An endorsement also be made in all such confiscated answer sheets by the Board/Observer to this effect.
- No representation for re-evaluation of answer sheet of Written Examination or re-conduct of written examination will be entertained.

5. PRACTICAL (SKILL) TEST (50 MARKS)

PHASE - III

- Candidates who qualify the written examination to the tune of ten times category wise vacancies will be called to appear in Practical (Skill) Test on the basis of marks secured in Written Examination.
- ii) Practical (Skill) Test will carry 50 marks and qualifying marks for all categories will be 50%. However, Practical (Skill) Test shall be qualifying in nature. Skill Test is divided into following parts:-

MERIT LIST

- i) After completion of Practical (Skill) Test, Merit List in each category namely, General (UR), Sechduled Caste (SC), Scheduled Tribe (ST), OBC (NCL), EWS and Ex-servicemen category will be drawn on the basis of marks obtained by the candidates in written examination. On the basis of merit and category wise vacancies, candidates shall be shortlisted for Detailed Medical Examination (DME). The number of candidates examined will be equal to the number of vacancies increased by average failure rate of DME/RME determined on the basis of past experience. However, there shall be no reserve list.
- ii) SC, ST, OBC (NCL) & EWS candidates who are selected on their own merit without relaxed standards will not be adjusted against the vacancies of reserved categories. Such SC, ST, OBC (NCL) & EWS candidates shall be accommodated against the General (Un-reserved) vacancies as per their position in overall merit list. The reserved vacancies will be filled up separately from amongst the eligible SC, ST, OBC (NCL) & EWS candidates, which will, thus, comprise of SC, ST, OBC (NCL) & EWS candidates who are lower in merit than the last General (UR) candidate on merit list of un-reserved category, but otherwise found suitable for appointment even by relaxed standard.
- iii) If vacancy reserved for Ex-servicemen remained unfilled due to non-availability of eligible or qualified

Ex-servicemen candidates, the same shall be filled up from the non Ex-servicemen candidates of respective categories, as per merit list. iv) Resolution of Tie Cases: a) In case of tie in marks, the candidates with older age will be placed higher in the merit b) If tie still persist, then the candidate whose name comes first in the alphabetical order (English) will be kept higher in the merit list. PHASE - IV DETAILED Candidates who qualify the PET, PST, Verification of MEDICAL original documents (Documentation), Written EXMINATION Examination and Practical (Skill) Test etc. and selected in order of merit as per category wise number (DME) of vacancies will put through Detailed Medical Examination (DME) to assess their fitness. Detailed Medical Examination of the candidates will be conducted in terms of Uniform guidelines for recruitment Medical Examination for GOs and NGOs in CAPFs and AR issued vide MHA U.O No. A.VI-1/2014-Rectt(SSB) dated 20.05.2015 and A.VI.I/14-Rectt(SSB) dated 24.08.2015 and as amended from time to time, by the Government. Candidates will either be declared "FIT" or REVIEW 8 "UNFIT" in Medical Examination and those who will MEDICAL **EXAMINATION** be declared "UNFIT" during Detailed Medical Examination (DME) will be allowed to undergo (RME) Review Medical Examination (RME), subject to providing their written consent by appending their signature, indicating the reasons for being unfit as per Annexure-'VII'. The consent for RME as per Annexure-'VII' duly signed by the candidate will be submitted within 24 hours after he is informed for his unfitness in DME. (ii) The candidates who have been declared Unfit in DME will be briefed about the procedure for submission of their consent for RME at the venue. (iii) The Review Medical Examination (RME) of candidates will be conducted in continuation of DME, preferably on the next day. Data of such candidates who are declared "UNFIT" in DME and submitted written consent for RME will be provided by

Presiding Officer. After completion of RME process,

result of RME will be handed over to Presiding Officer forthwith.

(iv) There shall be no provision of "Temporary Unfit". Medical Officers should give their verdict as "FIT" or "UNFIT" in respect of each candidate.

(v) The decision of the Review Medical Board of ITBP shall be final and no 2nd appeal will be entertained and reply of the correspondence/2nd appeal will also not be given/entertained.

NOTE:

Those who do not qualify any stage will get eliminated from the process there only and will not be allowed to appear in further tests.

7. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:
